
Pl. I: Figurines from 'Ain Ghazal.





















































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























3. Tibia of an adult or older individual of unknown sex showing 3 trephine holes side by side (running no. 64, burial 9).


Pl. CXIX: Individual burial no. 33 in situ showing trephine hole in the left humerus (see also magnification).






















Pl. CXXII, 2: Minaean graffito from Krum al-Ghuzlan.




Pl. CXXIII, 1: Wadi Rajil: Waterfall in flood






Pl. CXXIV, 1: Modern Petroglyph of equid showing "rocking-blade" technique
































Pl. CXXXIV, 2 Cooking pot, reg. nr. 2764, surface find (MB).




Pl. CXXXIV, 3 Pottery model of chart, reg. nr. 2752, phase II


